CANCELLATION -- In the event your plans change and your child will not be attending camp, please notify us immediately. Some Art Camp weeks sell out every year and it is expected that other children will be on a waiting list. We will be able to replace your child if we have enough notice. PLEASE NOTE: We cannot guarantee a refund if time does not allow us to replace your child with a standby.

DROP OFF and PICK-UP -- On the first day of your child's camp week, please bring your child shortly before the start time and stay with your child until our Camp Director addresses the group. There will be a short explanation about the traffic pattern, highway safety, pick-up times and locations, etc. After the first day, you may drop your children at the front door. We will be there to greet them. Please keep close to the car in front of you so we don't have parents waiting out on the highway in the left turn lane.

PLEASE NOTE: If your child has permission to leave the premises with another person, please provide us with a signed note for our files stating your permission.

DRESS -- Classes will be held inside the Art Center (air conditioned), in the Pottery Barn, and outside (weather permitting). The Campers should dress comfortably keeping in mind the possibility of getting messy with paint, paste, clay, etc. Please do not let your child wear clothes that would be inappropriate for getting "art" on them! **WHEN DOING ART – DRESS THE PART.** All of the art materials will be provided.

SNACKS – Campers are asked to bring their own drink and snack. Bottled water will always be available.

BEHAVIOR -- Campers are expected to behave properly while at camp. Inappropriate behavior can result in expulsion from camp and no refund will be given. We're here to have fun with art in a safe, creative and supportive environment.

Please keep in mind the Summer Art Camps are sponsored by individuals, businesses and corporations. In order to keep the cost for families down, please continue to support the arts with your membership dues and donations.

And the most important point:

"Mom! Look at what I did!" "Dad! My art teacher said I was pretty good at this."

Sharing enthusiasm is a very important part of the art camp experience. Ask your camper, "What did you do today?" It is expected that the pottery barn projects will not be finished by the last day of camp. Come back with your child to pick up this project as instructed.
